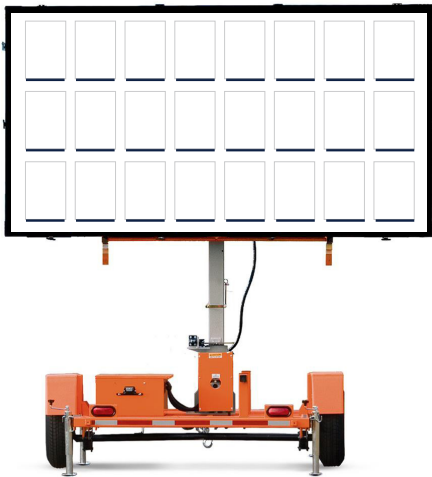
Step 3: REPRESENT

Tell us who you are. If your screen poem is selected to be shown at Brilliant Baltimore, we will need this information to notify you.

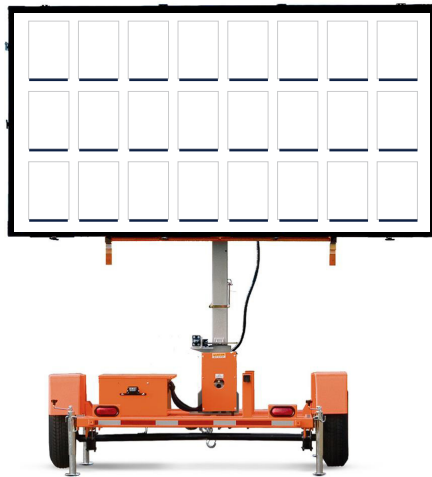

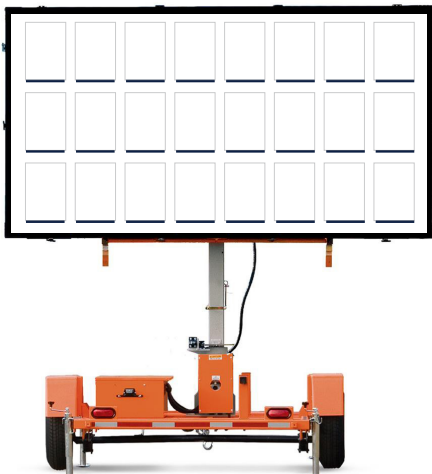

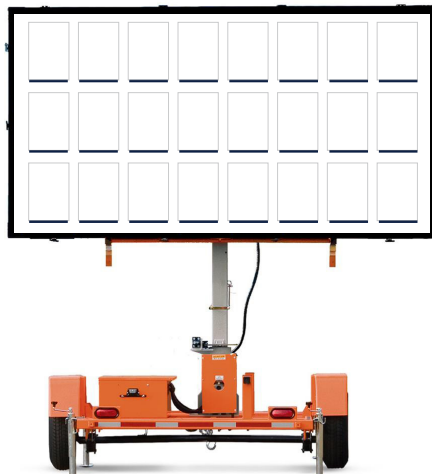
